**SUBJECT:** Fire Hall Preliminary Design Contract

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

That Council approve a contract with Liberty Contract Management for \$14,400 plus travel expenses (approximately \$3,012) to complete a preliminary design for the Fire Hall project, with any expenses above the budgeted amount to come from the Fire Department surplus.

**BACKGROUND:**

At their July 4, 2016 regular meeting, Council made the following resolutions:

R2016/25/10 MOVED by Councillor MacMullin, Seconded by Councillor Foster:

1. That the Village of Queen Charlotte seek grant funding in the amount of \$10,000 from the Ministry of Community, Sport and Cultural Development Infrastructure Planning Grant to hire a contractor to design a New Fire Hall/Emergency Operations and Emergency Social Services Centre.

CARRIED

2. That the Village of Queen Charlotte commit \$2000.00 as matching funds for the Infrastructure Planning Grant application from the Fire Department surplus.

CARRIED

Council was advised on October 14, 2016, that the grant application was successful. Quotes were sought from qualified companies to provide the following services:

- Conceptual drawings of the site plan, building elevations, floor plans, and colored perspectives
- Preliminary budget
- Preliminary schedule

Once the preliminary design is completed and costed, Council will have the information they need to seek funding prior to the final design and construction phases can be tendered.

Three bids were received and evaluated. The evaluation of the proposals was weighted and considered: Price (35%), Location (15% - based on buying local), past experience designing fire halls (25%), and references (25%). The bids are summarized below:
