

BOAT LAUNCH PHASE 2 COMPLETE – THE RAMP IS OPEN!

The final work on Phase 2 of the Boat Launch Upgrade project is now complete and the launch is again open to the public, just in time for the Paul Bentley Memorial Fishing Tournament next weekend.

A soft opening of the launch was held today at 4:30 pm. Grant funder representatives Gwaii Trust Alternate AI West, and Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) CEO Janine North, and members of the Village Council were in attendance to watch Billy Yovanovich, Chief Councillor of Skidegate Band Council launch the first boat from the new ramp.
