## **VOTING DATES AND LOCATIONS**

**GENERAL VOTING** will be open to qualified electors of the Village of Queen Charlotte on:

## **ELECTOR REGISTRATION**

**The Village of Queen Charlotte maintains its own Voters List (list of electors). *If you are not on the list of electors*, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:**

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day
- Canadian citizen

- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the Village of Queen Charlotte for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

**To register, resident electors** must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

**To register, non-resident property electors** must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the other property owners.

### MAIL BALLOT VOTING

Qualified electors may vote by mail if they:

- have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity
- expect to be absent from the Village of Queen Charlotte on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities

#### REQUESTING A MAIL BALLOT PACKAGE:

Before 4:00 pm on October 18, 2018 you must submit the following information to the Village of Queen Charlotte office by mail to PO Box 580, 903 A Oceanview Drive, fax 250 559 4742 or email [office@queencharlotte.ca](mailto:office@queencharlotte.ca):

- (1) Full name,
- (2) Residential address,
- (3) Address of the property in relation to which you are voting (for non-resident property electors),
- (4) Method of delivery of your mail ballot package:
  - (a) pick up at Village of Queen Charlotte office, OR
  - (b) regular mail through Canada Post to residential address, OR
  - (c) regular mail through Canada Post to an alternate address provided when requesting the ballot package,
- (5) If you are not on the list of electors, to ensure you receive the correct registration application form in their package, you must indicate whether you are going to be registering as a resident or non-resident property elector.

The Village will send out mail ballot packages commencing on or about October 1, 2018. To be counted, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief election officer no later than 8:00 pm on Saturday October 20, 2018.
