I hereby waive any and all claims that I may now and in the future have against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue the Village of Queen Charlotte and their respective agents, officers, employees, volunteers or representatives (the “Released Parties”) for any loss, damage, personal or bodily injury, death sustained or suffered by me as a result of the Village of Queen Charlotte private property camping permit due to any cause whatsoever, including without limitation, negligence, fault or breach of statutory duty, including duties arising from the *Occupiers Liability Act*.

In no event will the Village of Queen Charlotte be liable for any loss, damage, personal or bodily injury or death nor for any loss of or damage (including indirect or consequential damages) that my property suffers whether attributable to or arising out of the Village of Queen Charlotte private property camping permit or by reason of any matter or thing done or permitted.

I confirm that I am the age of majority and that I have read and understood this agreement prior to signing it and agree that this agreement will be binding upon me (as a participant), my heirs, executors and administrators.
