Participating is EASY

Drop Off:

All residents can drop off their materials at the Causeway between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. General donations will be accepted for the QC Youth Centre in support of their activities (recommended donation \$5).

Curb Side Pick-up:

The Fire Department is offering a curb side pick-up by donation (recommended donation \$20) in support of the new Fire Hall. Arrangements to pick up large items, or for seniors needing assistance, can be made by registering for the event at www.queencharlotte.ca. The **reservation must be confirmed** by the Village by **May 26, 2016** to be included in the curb-side pick-up fundraiser. Materials must be out or accessible by 8:00 am on the morning of pick-up.

- Stoves/dishwashers/washers/dryers/ small appliances
- Boxsprings and mattresses
- Broken glass (safely packaged)
- Furniture
- Hot water tanks
- Lawn furniture
- Toys (bikes)
- Carpet in 3 foot lengths
- Bagged loose material in clear bags
- Leaf and yard waste that is separately bagged/bundled and tied
- Wood (pallets/lumber)
- Propane tanks

- Recyclables

I hereby waive any and all claims that I may now and in the future have against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue the Village of Queen Charlotte and their respective agents, officers, employees, volunteers or representatives (the “Released Parties”) for any loss, damage, personal or bodily injury, death sustained or suffered by me as a result of my volunteering due to any cause whatsoever, including without limitation, negligence, fault or breach of statutory duty, including duties arising from the *Occupiers Liability Act*.

In no event will the Village of Queen Charlotte be liable for any loss, damage, personal or bodily injury or death nor for any loss of or damage (including indirect or consequential damages) that I suffer whether attributable to or arising out of my volunteering or by reason of any matter or thing done or permitted.
