- Stoves/dishwashers/washers/dryers/ small appliances
- Boxsprings and mattresses
- Broken glass (safely packaged)
- Furniture
- Hot water tanks
- Lawn furniture
- Toys (including bikes)
- Carpet in 3 foot lengths
- Bagged loose material in clear bags
- Leaf and yard waste that is separately bagged/bundled and tied
- Wood (pallets/lumber)
- Propane tanks

What's Out?

- Fridges/freezers
- Recyclables
- Tires/cars/vehicles/boats
- Loose materials
- Animal carcasses
- Liquid wastes
- Renovations or construction debris
- Waste oil/filters/automotive parts/batteries
- Hazardous explosives/toxic waste/contaminated soil
- Electronics (TV's, computers/printers, stereos, VCR/DVDs, phones etc.)
- Commercial or business waste
