



Village of Queen Charlotte Assistant Youth Coordinator – Summer Position

Are you interested in working with youth in our community? Do you have ideas for fun summer events? The Village of Queen Charlotte is seeking an Assistant Youth Coordinator for the months of July and August 2019. You will work directly with the Youth Program Manager to facilitate, coordinate and lead outdoor youth adventure programming for ages 10 to 18, as well as providing a safe, fun, and inclusive atmosphere for drop-in/hang out time at the Youth Centre. You will gain problem solving and program development skills while delivering fun and challenging opportunities for the youth of our community.

The position is available during the summer time, 5 days a week, 7 hours per day, 35 hours per week.

The successful candidate will be:

- Between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- A Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*; and legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial / territorial legislation and regulations;
- Interested in and/or experienced with youth program planning and delivery, youth and family support work, or recreation coordination.

The rate of pay will be \$15.00/hour plus 10% in lieu of vacation and benefits.
