

# Group Discussion


- We will be following an adapted World Café format.

- Council and staff are looking for input that they can use in future planning, in priorities for 2022, and in the 2022 – 2025 Council Strategic Plan.




# Group Discussion

- Council and staff will use the information from these sessions to identify & plan for the next sessions and future engagements.


What is most important to you in the discussion of a potential name change for the Village?

# WHAT WE HEARD AT KNOWvember on NOV 29TH

- *Will the name change go to referendum?*

*A: Council has not yet made any decisions on methodology and feel it is very important for community guidance and input on what method of achieving consensus will be used. This is why the discussion tables are so important. Discussion will allow residents to debate the possible options for establishing consensus that may include referendum. Council will use this feedback to inform their decision.*

- *Decision about name change should be by homeowners only.*

- *What is the time line for the name discussion?*

*A: A timeline will be identified and suggested by the community. Council has not imposed a timeline or deadline and will be taking input for the community into consideration.*

- *Has Council discussed the name change with other municipalities?*

*A: Council is at the preliminary stages for discussing the Village name. Council is looking for input and guidance from the community and will explore this option if it comes up as a suggestion. Thus it is important for everyone to discuss and direct this process.*

- *Will there be government representation?*

- *What will the Haida-language translation street signs look like?*

*A: We will have a mockup for our next meeting*
