

Notice of Repealing and Substituting - Council Procedure Bylaw No. 36-2010 and amendments

Pursuant to Section 124 (3) of the Community Charter, notice is hereby given that Council will be considering repealing Council Procedure Bylaw No. 36-2010 by giving readings to Council Procedure Bylaw No. 153-2022 at its Regular Open meeting of Monday August 15 2022 at 7:30 pm. This bylaw will substitute Council Procedure Bylaw 36-2010 with an across-the-board review in an effort to ensure the bylaw is current and effective: Some of the main changes include:

- Replacing Queen Charlotte name with Daajing Giids
- Expanding and clarifying the definitions
- Moving the time of the meetings, clarifying meeting scheduling procedures and guidance to the establishment of the annual regular meeting calendar
- Clarifying electronic meeting procedures
- General revisions to ensure alignment with current provincial legislation governing municipal procedures
